### Instituto d'Istruzione Superiore Einstein-Nebbia di Loreto, Italy

The school is situated in Loreto, a small town in the Marche region, in the centre of Italy, close to the Adriatic sea. In the Istituto d'Istruzione Superiore "Einstein- Nebbia" of Loreto study boys and girls from 14 to 18 years old.

The school was funded in the school year 2000/2001 from the merger of two prestigious and consolidated schools - the ISTITUTO TECNICO COMMERCIALE "Albert Einstein" (Accounting School) and the ISTITUTO ALBERGHIERO "Antonio Nebbia" (Catering School). At the end of the third year, it is possible for the students to get a diploma certifying their professional abilities. It is also possible for them to attend lessons for two more years and, at the end of the fifth year, to be awarded a high school diploma which gives them access to all university faculties.

The school prepare students

To enter the professional world of accountancy and business administrations as well as of tourism and hotel management.

#### The Courses

The courses available at the Istituto Alberghiero are divided into three different branches: **Reception**, whereby students learn how to carry out reception and secretarial work in hotels; **Cooking**, whereby students learn how perform recipes for cold and hot dishes; and **Bar** which prepares students to carry out dining room service and to welcome customers into the restaurant.

The Istituto Tecnico Commerciale is composed of two sections: **Igea** and **Marketing**

Activities within European school exchange projects are manifold. For the Comenius and Leonardo Projects, the students are engaged in an intense activity of stage in England, Finland, Germany, France and Cyprus. As required by law n.104/92 on school integration of the disabled, students with special needs are integrated in the mainstream classes. Currently there are 42 SEN students.
